- provide all information requested in Sections 1 to 3 of the application form
- include copies of all the required documents listed in Section 4 of the application form
- initial each statement in Section 5 of the application form
- sign and date the application in Section 6 of the application form

YOU MAY CHECK THE STATUS OF YOUR APPLICATION AT ANY TIME BY VISITING OUR WEBSITE AT <http://transportation.unm.edu/lic/status.htm> You will be asked to register by typing your name and a password provided by IPL. The status reports are updated in real time. To expedite the application process, we ask that you not call IPL for this type of information unless you are having an online problem.

WHAT HAPPENS ONCE YOU SUBMIT THIS APPLICATION:

The Traffic Safety Bureau will review your application within 15 days *if* it is complete. Applications will be reviewed in the order in which they are received. ***Applications will not be considered complete until the TSB receives all required documents, including the MVD and DPS reports.***

If the application is *not* complete, the TSB will email you regarding the missing information or documents. If the TSB does not receive the missing information or documents within 20 days of the date of the email, your application will be returned to you. You may resubmit a complete application at any time.

If the TSB does not approve your application, you will receive a letter stating the reasons why it was not approved. If the reasons can be resolved, you may resubmit your application.

If the TSB approves your application you will be issued an Ignition Interlock Installer Certificate.

NO PERSON MAY INSTALL, SERVICE, OR REMOVE IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES UNLESS AND UNTIL THE TRAFFIC SAFETY BUREAU HAS GRANTED WRITTEN APPROVAL BY ISSUING AN IGNITION INTERLOCK INSTALLER CERTIFICATE.

Please submit the following documents with your application:

- A certified copy of your **limited** driving history from MVD, **for any and all states in which you held a drivers license in the last five years**, dated no earlier than 60 days before the date the application is filed. You may submit a copy of the Request for MVD Limited Driving History form for the state of New Mexico available at <http://ipl.unm.edu/traf/certification/forms/MVD.doc> so that the TBS can obtain it directly. Please do not submit any other type of driving history. (If you have submitted an MVD report or request form with a service center license application, you do not need to submit it with this application.)
- A certified copy of your state criminal background check, **for any and all states in which you were an adult resident**, dated no earlier than 60 days before the date the application is filed. You may submit a copy of the Authorization for Release of Information by DPS form for the State of New Mexico available at <http://ipl.unm.edu/traf/certification/forms/DPS.doc> **This form must be notarized and accompanied by a check for \$10.00 made payable to the Department of Public Safety.** (If you have submitted a DPS report or request form with a service center license application, you do not need to submit it with this application.)
- A copy of your resume or curriculum vitae.
- A certificate of satisfactory completion from an automotive electronics training program or at least one year's verifiable experience with motor vehicle electrical systems.
- A copy of a certificate of satisfactory completion from an ignition interlock installer training program.

Section 5 – Sworn Statements.

_____ I have received a copy of, have read, and agree to comply with the requirements of, 18.20.11 NMAC, Ignition Interlock Devices, the rule adopted by the Traffic Safety Bureau regarding the ignition interlock program.

_____ I will impose the same fees on all drivers for installing, servicing, leasing and removing ignition interlock devices, but shall collect from indigent drivers only half of the leasing fee. The service center shall reimburse the bureau for any overpayments obtained from the bureau in violation of this section.

_____ I understand that failure to comply with the requirements of the rule shall be grounds for suspension or revocation of any certificate issued to me by the Traffic Safety Bureau.

_____ I have not been sanctioned in any jurisdiction for circumventing or tampering with an ignition interlock device. *If you have been so sanctioned, please provide detailed information regarding the jurisdiction, the year, and the circumstances.*

_____ I will not install, service, or remove any ignition interlock device in New Mexico until I have received a certificate as an Ignition Interlock Installer from the Traffic Safety Bureau.
